# Capri 30

is a brand-new 30' five-sleeper auxiliary designed by Sparkman and Stephens and built by Chris-Craft. With all-fiberglass construction, keel centerboard, and sloop rig, she's idealy suited for both family cruising and racing. A tall mast and short boom offer easy handling for the cruising skipper, and all the height the competition sailor needs for large headsails (a masthead rig is standard).

#### Capri 30

has a wide, uncluttered, non-skid deck on which sail handling or lounging are equally pleasurable. The self-bailing cockpit is unusually large, with plenty of storage space beneath each seat.

#### Capri 30

has a luxurious cabin, tastefully decorated and with natural mahogany trim. There's a private forward stateroom, enclosed lavatory, modern galley with full equipment and lots of counter space, wide lounge, and a dinette which converts to a double berth. Famed Chris-Craft "space engineering" has provided enough room below to make living aboard as comfortable as on the big boats (headroom, for example is 6'2½").

is inexpensive to operate and requires a minimum amount of upkeep. For the sailing family of modest income, it presents an excellent opportunity to own a boat of the finest quality and with the very best sailing characteristics.
